### NOTICE TO ALL RETIRED EMPLOYEES OF VISKASE CANADA INC. AT THE LINDSAY PLANT (AND THEIR BENEFICIARIES) OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT OF CLASS ACTION – THIS NOTICE MAY AFFECT YOUR RIGHTS. PLEASE READ CAREFULLY.

#### NOTICE

This notice is directed to all former employees of Viskase Canada Inc. at the Lindsay Plant in receipt of post-retirement life insurance and health care benefits as of December 14, 2006 and their beneficiaries in respect of same.

#### PURPOSE OF THIS NOTICE

A proposed class action lawsuit was initiated against Viskase Canada Inc. and Viskase Companies Inc. (the "Defendants") in which James Ireland and Arol Fairbairn (the "Representative Plaintiffs") alleged that the Defendants wrongfully terminated premium payments in reference to life insurance and health care benefits for its retired employees. Although the Defendants deny any liability, an agreement has been reached to settle the lawsuit (the "Settlement" or "Settlement Agreement").

In order for the Settlement to become effective, it must be approved by the Ontario Supreme Court of Justice. A hearing will be held at the Barrie Courthouse, located at 114 Worsley Street, Barrie, Ontario, at 2:15 on April 22, 2008. At that hearing the Ontario Superior Court of Justice will decide whether or not the Settlement should be approved.

#### CLASS PROPOSED

At the hearing on April 22, 2008, the parties will seek to certify the case for the purpose of effecting the Settlement on behalf of the following class:

All former employees of the Defendant's Lindsay Plant who were in receipt of post-retirement and health care benefits as of December 14, 2006, and their beneficiaries under a group life insurance policy.

#### TERMS OF THE PROPOSED SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

Viskase, while not admitting any liability, has agreed to:

- (1) reinstate life insurance coverage for eligible Class Members;
- (2) make payment of \$10,000.00 to each life insurance beneficiary of a Class Member who has passed away since February 1, 2007;
- (3) make payments on account of health benefits to eligible Class Members (and their spouses who are entitled to coverage) any of whom are under the age of 65 as of February 1, 2007, in the amount of \$200 per year for each year until reaching the age of 65;

#### LEGAL COSTS & FEES

Class Counsel have funded the time and expenses incurred in pursuing the litigation. The Settlement Agreement, as approved by the Court, provides for payment by the

Defendants to Class Counsel of \$125,000.00 CAD. Class members may retain their own lawyers to assist them in making individual claims to the Settlement. Class Members are responsible for paying the legal fees of any additional legal services they seek.

#### SETTLEMENT APPROVAL HEARING

If you are a member of the proposed class and you do not oppose Settlement, you need not appear at the Settlement Approval hearing or take any other action at this time. If you are a member of the proposed Class and you wish to comment on or make an objection to the terms of the Settlement Agreement, you are encouraged to send your name, address and brief reasons for the objection to Class Counsel at the address and fax number listed below, prior to April 8, 2008. Class Counsel will forward all such submissions to the Court and you will be entitled to appear at the Approval Hearing April 22, 2008 and be heard if you wish to do so.

If the Court approves the Settlement, a further Notice will be mailed to Class Members.

#### OPTING OUT

If the Settlement Agreement is approved, Class Members shall have the right to exclude themselves from the settlement by "opting out" In order to opt out of the settlement, Class Members will be required to send an Opt Out Form to Class Counsel at the address or fax number listed below before the Opt Out deadline. If you do opt out, you will not be bound by the Court Order approving Settlement, and you will not receive any of the Settlement benefits.
